Name of Process: Sharing of Student Representatives details between Edinburgh Napier University and Edinburgh Napier Student's Association (ENSA) as joint Data Controllers.

Description of Process:

Edinburgh Napier University conducts elections for Programme Representatives (Reps) on behalf of ENSA and shares this information with ENSA.

The information is used by both organisations to ensure that the Reps are able to make representations to the University on behalf of their class colleagues, attend and contribute to appropriate committees, councils and other such groups, there is open communication, collaboration and excellent staff-student body relationships.

Purposes for	The purposes of processing are:
collection/processing	 To enable ENSA to provide training, support and advice, and ensure that all matters relating to student representation are done in line with the ENSA constitution. To enable the University to communicate and collaborate with Reps to ensure an excellent student experience.

Legal basis	The University shares personal data with ENSA under GDPR Article 6(1)(c) as processing is necessary for a legal obligation under the Education Act 1994 s.22. As ENSA is established under this same instrument there exists a legal obligation for sharing data between the University, as the institution through which ENSA is established, and ENSA for the purposes outlined above.
