Who is the information being collected from	Via UCAS application and additional information directly from the applicant
How is the information being collected	UCAS system and University online form or as applicant preference e.g. email (initially)

Who keeps the information updated	Applicants must inform the University of any updates to their information.
How long is the information kept for	Unsuccessful applicants' data will be deleted the year following their application. Successful applicants' data will be retained for 6 years after they leave the University.
Will the data be used for any automated decision making	The system is designed to ensure placements are within reasonable travel distance of applicants' residential addresses. Placements are not purely automated.
