

#### Layered Privacy Notice Principal's Office External Communications

Activity/Processing being undertaken: Communications from the Principal's Office to external contacts - Principal email update, invites from the University to events, appropriate emails from the Development & External Relations Department, meeting requests or invites from the university to events and other such information sharing emails from Principal office staff.

Edinburgh Napier University provides this information to explain how we use your personal data. Protecting your personal data is important to us and we only collect and process data which is necessary for us to provide the information, services and goods you require. This is in compliance with UK data protection legislation ("the legislation"), that is, the UK Data Protection Act 2018 ("DPA 2018") and the General Data Protection Regulation: EU 2016-679 ("GDPR") as amended by "EU Exit" Regulations 2019 and now known as the UK GDPR.

# Who is collecting the information?

Edinburgh Napier University as the "Data Controller".

# Who are we sharing your Personal Data with (externally)?

We will not share the data with any external party

The University undertakes to maintain your information securely and will restrict access to employees, our professional advisers, authorised agents and contractors on a strictly need to know basis. We will only disclose your data to external third parties (other than any specified above) where we:

- Are required to do so under a statutory or legal obligation, or
- Are permitted to do so by Data Protection legislation.

# Why are we collecting it/what we are doing with it (purposes)?

To provide you with relevant communications and updates from the Principal's Office.

# What is the legal basis for processing?

The purposes above fall under one of two conditions for processing outlined by the GDPR. These are:

GDPR Article 6(1)(f) – Necessary for the purposes of legitimate interests pursued by the controller or a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests, rights or freedoms of the data subject"

GDPR Article 6(1)(a) – as per your consent which you can withdraw at any time by emailing <u>principal@napier.ac.uk</u>

# How are we collecting this information?

Directly from individuals

# What information are we collecting (whose information and what type of personal data)?

Name, job title, email address and telephone number.

#### Who can see your information within the University?

Appropriate staff within the Principal's Office and the Development & External Relations Department.

#### How long is your information kept?

We will keep your personal data only for as long as we need it to administer your relationship with us or to ensure we do not communicate with you after you have asked us not to. When we no longer need the information we will always dispose of it securely.

#### Who keeps your information updated?

Key staff members within the Principal's Office and Development & External Relations Department when you provide an update.

# **Will your information be used for any automated decision making or profiling?** No

# Is information transferred to a third country? Outside the EEA and not included in the adequate countries list.

#### Is any other information available?
