Name of process: Transport Research Institute (TRI) survey

Edinburgh Napier University provides this information to explain how we use your personal data. Protecting your personal data is important to us and we only collect and process data which is necessary for us to provide the information, services and goods you require. Who can see your information within the University?

University staff within the Transport Research Institute (TRI) and the School of Engineering and the Built Environment.

How long is your information kept?

7 years from the date it is collected, unless you request us to remove your details from our database. You can do this by contacting tri.general@napier.ac.uk

Who keeps your information updated?

TRI’s Administrator as advised by yourself or based on the responses you provide to the survey and events you attend.

Will your information be used for any automated decision making?

No.
